The Chelmsford Art Society is offering the Shirley Lavoie Memorial Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 to a deserving graduating high school Senior residing in Chelmsford. This scholarship will be awarded to a student who has indicated a desire to further his or her education in **Fine Arts/Visual Arts** at a **recognized school of art education. Verification of college acceptance must accompany this application.**

Applicants will be judged on their drawing ability, creativity, and understanding and use of color, design and composition in a variety of media. The proper presentation of work will be carefully considered by the Scholarship Committee. Recipient will be notified and public recognition will be made at the CAS Annual 4th of July Art Festival. **The scholarship winner is expected to attend the award ceremony on July 2, and is also expected provide several matted or framed pieces for display at the Art Festival.**

Payment of the \$1,000.00 award will be made **directly to the school** at which the applicant has been accepted and enrolled.

Completed application and personal statement must be received by **Saturday, April 21, 2018**. In person interviews are **mandatory** and will take place **Saturday, April 28, 2018**.

PROCEDURE REQUESTED BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE:

1. You are asked to prepare a **portfolio** to be presented to the Selection Committee at the time of the personal interview. The portfolio is to contain **6 - 10 pieces** of your work in a variety of media.
2. All 2-dimensional work must be finished pieces of artwork presented in a professional manner. Large 3-dimensional work may be presented on a personal iPad or laptop computer.
3. Each application is to be accompanied by a **personal statement** written by you telling the committee about yourself, outlining your interest in art, and why you have chosen Fine / Visual Art as your college major. Please include any awards you have won, art classes taken outside of school or shows you have entered. **Application deadline is Saturday, April 21, 2018.**
4. **A letter verifying acceptance in an art school or college** must accompany this application.
5. Portfolios will be judged on drawing ability, creativity, and understanding and use of color, design and composition in a variety of media.
6. All applicants must be **interviewed** by the Selection Committee. Appointments will be made following the screening of all applicants. Interviews will be conducted **Saturday, April 28, 2018.** You will be notified of the time of your interview.
